Posters presented at the Northwest Pharmacy Convention will be judged by a panel for content, presentation, and importance to the future practice of pharmacy. The posters will be on display in the hallway Friday, June 4th from 10 am to 7:30 pm.

- Pharmacy Practice and Research Posters Form
- An electronic copy of your abstract using the Abstract Format Form
- The name(s) of the individual(s) who will be attending the Convention as presenters of the poster.

In order to qualify for the Awards of Distinction, each poster must have one person registered at the Convention who is responsible for answering questions regarding the poster. Posters will be judged during the Exhibit hours. Poster presenters are encouraged but not required to stop by to answer questions.

Set-up specifics:

- The Poster Session is located in the conference lobby area
- Set-up time will be Friday, June 4th from 8 am - 10 am
- Poster boards are 4' tall x 8' wide, please limit the size of your poster to fit the poster board
- Authors are responsible for bringing their own display materials (i.e. double stick tape or Velcro tabs) to mount and set up posters. **Note: Push pins do not work on these poster boards**
- Authors are encouraged to provide handout materials relating to their papers.
- Poster take down time is 7:30 – 8 pm on Friday June 4th. Any posters remaining after 8 pm may be discarded. The WSPA is not responsible for posters not removed by presenters.

Posters will be evaluated individually based on a standard rubric rather than an Evaluation Category and their scores will be compared to posters within the same Practice Category.

Awards of Distinction will be presented in the following **Practice Categories:**

- All Pharmacists including Pharmacy Residents
- Student Pharmacists and Technicians*

*if a Student Pharmacist or Technician is the primary author, the poster will be judged in the Student Pharmacist and Technician Section.

Winners in each category will receive one complimentary registration to the 2011 Northwest Pharmacy Convention meeting (up to \$310).

Each poster will be assigned a number prior to the Convention and designated into a category, Pharmacist/Pharmacy Resident or Student Pharmacist/Pharmacy Technician.

We will contact you by May 21st to let you know if your poster has been found acceptable to be displayed at the Northwest Convention. Thank you and good luck!
